### 001 **Mâcon-Lugny Les Genièvres, Louis Latour, 2017/18**

Mâconnais, Burgundy, France

Bright favourite from the Latour stable, with fresh grassy notes, plenty of tropical fruit and a firm roundness. Good ripe Chardonnay, with a touch of age. (2) 13.0% vol, Vegetarian

Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine, Loire, France

Dry, crisp and fresh with a sea breeze and light almond character. Carries a light and easy natural style. (1) 12.0% vol, Vegan

### 003 **Lost Weekend Chardonnay, Hesketh, 2017/18**

South Australia, Australia

Fragrant scents of honeydew melon and fresh peach, with seamlessly integrated French oak. Crisp notes of nectarine with toast and brioche flavours on the finish make this an elegant and well-balanced wine. (2) 13.0% vol, Vegetarian

California, USA

Medium sweet rosé, displaying classic strawberry fruit flavours. (4) 10.5% vol

A delightfully crisp and refreshing white wine. Citrus fruit aromas and floral notes combine on the nose. On the palate, a balanced acidity, light body and a lasting finish. (1) 12.5% vol, Vegan

Central Valley, Chile

San Juan, Argentina

Argentina's white grape shows its character here with a pretty floral nose reminiscent of fresh fruit salad. The palate shows white flower and tropical fruit, wonderfully aromatic. (2) 13.5% vol, Vegan

Campo de Borja, Spain

Stunning Spanish rosé with its delicate pink colour and aromas of strawberry jam. The style is dry yet commercial with some mid-palate sweetness. (2) 13.5% vol

Veneto, Italy

Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. (1) 11.0% vol, Vegan

Veneto, Italy

Champagne, France

021 **Tamari Malbec, 2018/19**

Mendoza, Argentina

Soft red fruit notes with elegantly smooth tannins and a lingering finish. A great example of Argentina's hallmark red wine. (C) 13.0% vol, Vegan

San Juan, Argentina

Richly coloured and scented it is an easy-drinking blend. With Shiraz taking centre stage to give a smoky, spicy palate supported by a firm Malbec grip. (B) 13.0% vol, Vegan

Riverina, New South Wales, Australia

Sweet cherry fruit with silky cocoa and chocolate tannins. Intense black cherries are supported by hints of vanilla and earthy aromas making this a Shiraz worth discovering. (C) 13.0% vol, Vegetarian

024 **Côtes du Rhône, Auguste Bessac, 2017/18**

Côtes du Rhône, Rhône, France

- Young and well-ripened, this Rhône red is wonderfully easy-drinking with light berry fruit style. (B) 13.0% vol, Vegan

- 025 **Terra Iconia Beaujolais, 2016/17**  
Beaujolais, Burgundy, France  
An abundance of intense berry fruits such as redcurrant, blackberry and blueberry. A subtle, floral peony fragrance lingers on the palate and combines with mineral notes and round, silky tannins to give a balanced glass with a lengthy, fruity finish. (A) 12.5% vol, Vegetarian

- 026 **Valmoissine Pinot Noir, Louis Latour, 2015/16**  
Côteaux du Verdon, South of France, France  
Valmoissine is the upland site of an ancient monastery, perfect for Pinot Noir. The proof is its fresh strawberry aroma and open flavours, the effect is of ripe softness. (B) 12.0% vol, Vegetarian

- 027 **Rumours Cabernet Sauvignon, 2018/19**  
Riverina, New South Wales, Australia  
Bright cassis and blackcurrant fruit with underlying chocolate vanilla oak tones which carry through to the palate then burst with ripe fruit sweetness on the finish. (C) 13.0% vol, Vegetarian

- 028 **Tor del Colle Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva, 2016/17**  
Abruzzo, Italy  
Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. (C) 13.5% vol, Vegan

- 029 **Cormoran Crianza, 2016/17**  
Rioja, Spain  
Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish. (C) 14.0% vol

- 030 **Coreto Red, 2017/18**  
Lisboa, Portugal  
Coreto could easily be your favourite daily wine. Medium-bodied, smooth, balanced alcohol and tannins with fresh herbal notes and berry fruit flavours. (C) 12.5% vol, Vegan

- 031 **Esk Valley Merlot-Cabernet-Malbec, 2016/17**  
Hawkes Bay, New Zealand  
Full dark red. Soft Merlot, firm Cabernet and ripe, dark Malbec come together perfectly in this smooth integrated blend. (D) 14.0% vol

- 032 **Urmeneta Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017/18**  
Central Valley, Chile

Dark, ruby colour, full of red fruit aromas, perfectly mixed with sweet vanilla and coconut notes. It has a fresh mouthfeel, medium body, soft tannins and a long, pleasant finish. (C) 13.0% vol

Central Valley, Chile

Medium bodied, soft tannins, with black fruit and sweet vanilla flavours. (B) 13.0% vol

It has a deep inky-black colour with spicy dark berry aromas. The voluptuous palate shows intense blackberry and liquorice, dark chocolate flavours. (D) 14.0% vol.
